On 1/9/58 [REDACTED] United States Air Force, Special Police, Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland, telephoned the Washington Field Office from Pennsylvania advising he knows the identity of President Kennedy's assassin. He also indicated he had been working on the "Kennedy case" but had not furnished this information to his commanding officer as [REDACTED] feared this officer was involved. [REDACTED] indicated he preferred to be contacted personally regarding this matter and Baltimore is instructed to conduct the interview.
