TRIAL OF SHAW SET FOR FEB. 13

Intention of Judge Is Announced

If a Criminal District Court judge has his way the con-spiracy case of Clay L. hay will go to trial on Feb. 14.

. Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. Monday announced & as his intention that the trial will begin on that day.

If it does, two weeks less than one year will have elapsed since Shaw's arrest on a charge of conspiracy to murder President John F. Kennedy.

A series of legal actions has delayed the trial. The latest was a limited continuance requested by the defense.

Judge Haggerty said the only way he knows of to delay the trial is for the defense to request a change of venue.

Even if such a request is made it will not delay the trial if it is denied.

Garrison has charged that Shaw conspired with accused assassia Lee Harvey Oswald, a deceased pilot, David W. Ferrle, and Jack Ruby, to kill Kennedy.

Shaw, former managing direcfor of the International Trade Mart, has denied the charge.
