BY DOCTOR DONALD A. WAITE, SEVEN FIVE SIX HADDON AVENUE, COLLINGSWOOD,  
NEW JERSEY, REQUESTING A CERTIFIED COPY OF AMERICAN AIRLINES SCHEDULE  
FROM DALLAS TO EL PASO, TEXAS, FOR NOV. NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE. WAITE  
ALSO REQUESTED CERTIFIED COPIES OF OTHER AIRLINES. WAITE HAD POWER  
OF ATTORNEY FROM EDGAR E. BRADLEY OF CALIFORNIA AND OTHERS NOT  
IDENTIFIED. WAITE STATED BRADLEY WAS IN EL PASO HOTEL NOV. TWENTY-  
THREE NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE AND COULD PROVE BRADLEY COULD NOT HAVE BEEN  
IN DALLAS THAT DATE. BRADLEY STATED HE WAS PUBLISHER OR WRITER FOR  
A SMALL PAPER. WAITE FURTHER STATED HE WAS GOING TO CONTACT THE  
DALLAS PD FOR INFO. OKR DETERMINED WAITE HAD TAPE RECORDED DURING  
THEIR CONVERSATION. NO LHM BEING SUBMITTED.
