THIS REPRESENTATIVE STATED THAT A PERSON IDENTIFYING HIMSELF AS GILBERT BERGER OF THE NEW ORLEANS OFFICE HAD TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED RANDOM PEOPLE REQUESTING INFORMATION CONCERNING A RICHARD G. BERGER. THE INFORMATION BEING REQUESTED BY GILBERT BERGER SHOULD BE TELEPHONICALLY FURNISHED TO NEW ORLEANS.
