NOTE: Bufiles disclose Mrs. Daulton has been a correspondent since 1951. The information she has reported has been nebulous and usually concerned communism. Mrs. Daulton has been interviewed previously by Bureau Agents regarding information she wanted to furnish to the FBI and the consensus of opinion of the Bureau Agents who contacted her indicates she has an obsession for reporting data which seems suspicious to her but which has no basis in fact. A co-employee of Mrs. Daulton described her as a gossip who makes accusations without justification.
