Attached is a letter addressed to Senator Robert F. Kennedy bearing the signature [redacted] of St. Petersburg, Florida, which was referred to the Bureau by Miss Naomi F. Weinstein, Office of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. Miss Weinstein's letter was previously acknowledged.

[redacted] letter was rambling and incoherent, but due to the fact he made allegations that he had information there were three men who shot at the President and that he told other people President Kennedy was going to be shot, the field was instructed to conduct background investigation concerning [redacted] which was coordinated by the Dallas Office.

The attached letterhead memorandum sets forth the results of these inquiries, and it appears that [redacted] is identical with one [redacted] a man reported to be 76 or 77 years old.

The files of our San Antonio Office contain miscellaneous correspondence from one [redacted] the majority of which is illegible, and that which was legible was not sufficiently coherent to make sense. Records of the St. Petersburg, Florida, Police Department contain information concerning [redacted] noting their files contain two letters by [redacted] complaining about threats made against him by another individual.

The Tampa Division determined that [redacted] currently resides at [redacted] Petersburg, Florida, which is the same address furnished by [redacted] in his letter to Senator Robert F. Kennedy.
