I blso wish to make the statement that I was not specifically asked, while in the Jacksonville Office of the WI, whether I actually received a teletype on November 7, 1963 regarding an alleged attempt on the life of resident Mennedy. I denied while in the Jacksonville White furnishing any information to Mark Lane and said that Detoid Wark Lane that I never received any such assuge for communication.
