' BJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY NOVENBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

> The Student Union Board in conjunction with the Junior Class of American University, Washington, D. C., has announced that it is holding a Spring Weekend 5/11-12/68 which will be entitled "The Soul of Dixie." A program has been prepared by the sponsoring body at American University which sets forth the events which will be held in connection with this Spring Weekend.

The program of events (attached) listed for Sunday, 5/12/68, notes that James Carrison, the controversial District Attorney of the Parish of Orleans, will espouse his theories on the Kennedy assassination and the Warren Report and that lir. Garrison's speech will be followed with a reception in the Hughes-McDowell Connecting Lounge of American University.

OBSERVATIONS:

In past public appearances, Garrison has viciously attacked President Lyndon B. Johnson, the Warren Commission, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Dallas Police Department and other state and federal agencies. There is no reason to believe that Garrison's scheduled appearance. at American University will differ from other past public REC 5 62-10 9060=1 appearances by Garrison.
