Reference is made to your letter dated January 22, 1909, requesting investigation concerning the subject and to our various memoranda in response thereto, the most recent of which was dated April 10, 1968, at Los Angeles, California.

Enclosed is a copy of a memorandum dated April 25, -1968, at Kansas City, Missouri, which contains corroborating information concerning Bradley's presence in Wichita, Kansas, during the pertinent period in November, 1963. With regard to the information on page two of the enclosure which shows that a fellow employee recalled that Bradley became very excited when he learned of President Kennedy's assassination and indicated he must go to Miami, Florida, immediately, it is noted that our memorandum dated March 14, 1938, at Miami, Florida, which contains the results of our interview of Bradley on March 5, 1968, contains specific comments from Bradley concerning the basis for his strong reaction. During the interview, Bradley pointed out that, upon hearing of the assassination, he was greatly shocked and became "possessed" with the conviction that a conspiracy involving Cubans had caused the President's death.

Since our investigation has failed to indicate that Eradley received or carried out any assignment in the United States on behalf of the Cuban Government, since his presence in VNED Wichita, Kansas, at the time of the assassination has been established and since there is no evidence to indicate he has Ē any knowledge concerning the actual assassination of President Kennedy, we contemplate no further investigation in this matter.
