SUBJECT: Assassination of President
John Fitzgerald Kennedy
Dallas, Texas, November 22, 1963

With reference to the Bureau's memoranda of April 1, 4 and 6, 1968, we would appreciate being advised how many of the approximately 127 former employees of the Bureau's New Orleans office were employed in that office during the day of the event described by William S. Walter, and whether the Bureau has any recommendations regarding interview at this time of such employees. In addition, for the purpose of evaluating what, if any, additional action is necessary, we would appreciate receiving a copy of the Bureau's applicant investigation of Walter prior to his employment by the Bureau, as well as any information which would suggest or indicate that Walter is or has been subject to mental aberration or stress.

Please be assured that any information you furnish concerning Mr. Walter will be used solely within the Department and will receive no further dissemination.
