Criminal Court Judge Matthew S. Braniff issued orders directing Dr. Stanley I Dren-nan of Los Angeles and Clin-ton Aheat of Burney, Calif., to appear before the grand jury May 29 and 30.

In requesting the subpenas, the DA's office alleged that Dr. Drennan was present in 1963 at a discussion concerning the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. It fur-ther alleged that Wheat in 1963 participated in discussions at his home regarding the as-

sassination.

DA Jim Garrison has accused retired New Orleans businessman Clay L. Shaw with conspiring to kill President Kennedy. Shaw trial is set June H.
