Inasmuch as this interview was requested by United States Attorney Louis LaCour, the New Orleans Office should immediately furnish Mr. LaCour a copy of the LHM setting forth results of the interview of Walter. This data is also being disseminated to the Department at Seat of Government.

NOTE:

Walter is the former clerk of the New Orleans Office whom Garrison alleges possessed knowledge of an FBI teletype 11/17/63 to New Orleans reporting threat to President Kennedy in Texas. Walter has told conflicting stories regarding this communication and Department is considering possible criminal prosecution of him. On 5/8/68 U. S. Attorney LaCour informed New Orleans Office his assistant, Harry Connick, had a chance meeting with Lynn Loisel, an investigator attached to Garrison's office, on 5/6/68 and Loisel told Connick Walter had a "Government document." Walter was interviewed by Memphis 5/16/68 and denies having Government document or ever taking a Government document from FBI Office in New Orleans or that he ever made copies of a Government document or given them to anyone.
