ALCOCK SAID TODAY THAT HE HAS AMENDED A SUBPOENA REQUIRING
THE U.S. ARCHIVIST TO GIVE THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE
SECRET PHOTOGRAPHS AND X-RAYS OF THE BODY OF PRESIDENT JOHN F.
KENNEDY. ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE, ALCOCK SAID THAT UPON
INSTRUCTION OF THE U. S. MARSHAL'S OFFICE, THE SUBPOENA
WAS AMENDED TO REQUIRE THE CURRENT ARCHIVIST, DR. JOHN B.
RHODES, TO PRODUCE THE PHOTOGRAPHS AND X-RAYS IN THE DISTRICT
ATTORNEY'S OFFICE NEXT FRIDAY. ALCOCK SAID THE SUBPOENA HAD
BEEN AMENDED BECAUSE DR. ROBERT H. BAHMER NO LONGER HOLDS THE
POSITION OF ARCHIVIST.
