The State of Louisiana, making application to this Magistrate Court to charge one EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY presented to this Court as a witness:

MAX GONZALES, residing at 3800 Bissonet Drive, Metairie, Louisiana, who, upon being duly sworn by the Magistrate did depose and say as follows:

That the affiant, being a pilot, had occasion to go to the New Orleans Lakefront Airport in the City of New Orleans, Parish of Orleans, numerous times between June and August, 1963. On one such occasion during this time affiant saw DAVID W. FERRIE and another man talking at a booth in a restaurant on the airport premises. At this time your affiant had known DAVID W. FERRIE for at least five years. The man talking to FERRIE, the affiant identifies as the same person depicted in the picture initialed by affiant on January 16, 1968, and annexed to this Affidavit. Affiant has learned that the picture that he has initialed and identified as the person talking to DAVID W. FERRIE, and that is annexed hereto, is a picture of EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY.

About a week after seeing DAVID W. FERRIE and EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY talking in the airport restaurant, affiant had occasion to see DAVID FERRIE working on an airplane at the New Orleans Lakefront Airport. At this time FERRIE was talking to the same man who was with him at the restaurant about a week earlier. Affiant identifies this man talking to FERRIE as the same person depicted in the picture initialed by affiant on January 16, and annexed to this Affidavit. Affiant has learned that

picture that he has initialed and identified as the person talking to DAVID W. FERRIE, and that is annexed hereto, is a picture of EDGAR LUGENE BRADLEY.
