ReLAairtel 5/24/68 reporting results of a contact by attorney George J. Jensen with the Los Angeles Office concerning Edgar Eugene Bradley.

Sacramento Office should make no contacts nor conduct any investigation aimed at ascertaining the defense plans of Jensen for his client, Edgar Eugene Bradley. Bureau is following a strict course of action not to get involved in New Orleans District Attorney James C. Garrison's so-called probe of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Under no circumstances should any information be furnished to Jensen or Bradley.

Jensen, former FBI Agent, is now practicing law in the Los Angeles area. He is acting as the attorney for Edgar Eugene Bradley, the West Coast representative of Dr. Carl McIntire, the conservative New Jersey radio broadcaster who is extremely anti-communist. Garrison has charged Bradley as being involved in a conspiracy to assassinate President Kennedy. By airtel 5/24/68 Los Angeles Office reported Jensen contacted Los Angeles Office and solicited Bureau's assistance in discrediting District Attorney Garrison and thus prevent his client, Bradley, from being extradited to New Orleans, Louisiana. Los Angeles Office informed Jensen FBI could be of no assistance to him. Jensen volunteered

that he planned to use the Director's testimony before the Warren Commission which is published in Volume V of the Hearings of the Warren Commission Report as a defense for his client. Los Angeles Office instructed the Sacramento Office that unless advised to the contrary, Sacramento should contact established sources to determine what defense Jensen uses in endeavoring to defeat Bradley's extradition. The Director has previously instructed that Jensen is to get nothing from the FBI and it is our policy to stay completely clear of the Garrison investigation.
