THE NEW ORLEANS STATES-ITEM, RED FLASH EDITION, JUNE SIX INSTANT, CONTAINS AN ARTICLE WHICH DISCLOSES THAT ORLEANS PARISH ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS JAMES L. ALCOCK AND ANDREW SCIAMBRA ON INSTANT DATE MET WITH DEFENSE ATTORNEYS FOR CLAY L. SHAW, ACCUSED OF CONSPIRACY IN CONNECTION WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

THE ARTICLE RECALLED THAT U. S. DISTRICT COURT JUDGE FREDERICK J. R. HEEBE HAD GRANTED A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER PREVENTING THE TRIAL OF SHAW IN ORLEANS PARISH CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT ON JUNE ELEVEN NEXT AND THEN SIGNED AN ORDER PERMITTING SHAW'S ATTORNEYS TO TAKE DEPOSITIONS FROM ALCOCK, SCIAMBRA AND DA INVESTIGATORS LYNN LOISELL AND LOUIS IVON.

STATED THEY WERE NOT GOING TO REVEAL ANY INFORMATION CONCERNING  
THE INVESTIGATION TO SHAW'S ATTORNEYS.
