HARVEY OSWALD ACTED ALONE IN THE KILLING IS "VALID AND BINDING."

THE ARTICLE STATED THAT THE SPECIAL THREE-JUDGE FEDERAL COURT WAS CONVENED BECAUSE SHAW'S ATTORNEYS ARE ALSO ATTACKING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF A NUMBER OF STATE STATUTES WHICH HAVE BEEN USED IN SHAW'S PROSECUTION.

JUDGE HEEBE HAS CALLED A PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE IN THE CASE FOR THURSDAY AT TEN THIRTY A.M. HIS PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE ORDER DIRECTED THAT ALL ATTORNEYS FILE ANY AND ALL MOTIONS PRIOR TO THAT TIME. THE ARTICLE STATED THE CONFERENCE IS TO BE ATTENDED BY THE ATTORNEYS WHO WILL TRY THE CASE AND THEY WERE TOLD IN THE ORDER TO BE PREPARED "TO COMPROMISE SETTLEMENT POSSIBILITIES." THE ORDER ALSO ADDED "NO CONTINUANCE WILL BE GRANTED IN THIS MATTER EXCEPT ON A SHOWING OF GOOD CAUSE. SHOULD GOOD CAUSE BE SHOWN, CONTINUANCE WILL BE GRANTED ONLY ON THE FILING OF A MOTION AND ORDER FOR SAME."
