Ruth Louise had worked for a Child Day Care Center at the Eastland Christian Church, 2230 Jefferson Street, Anderson, Indiana as a music teacher. Ruth Louise plays the piano at the Day Care Center.

Mrs. McAllister advised Ruth Louise lives in a "fantasy world." She sees an important event in a newspaper or on television and becomes so involved in her mind she thinks herself into the situations. Ruth Louise writes letters

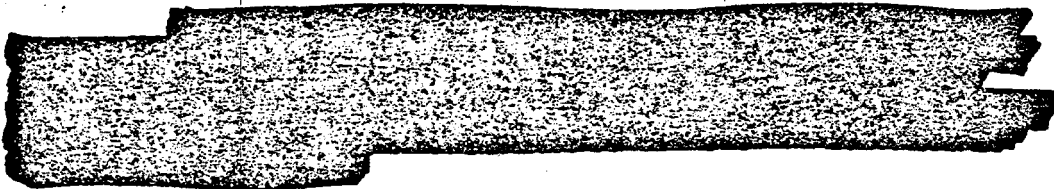
