Re Los Angeles letter to the Bureau and other receiving offices dated 5/21/70.

RONALD ROSS, Deputy District Attorney, Los Angeles County, advised that the subject is currently assigned to the California State Prison at Chino on a term of five years to life. He advised the subject's attorney and his cousin, [REDACTED], have filed numerous motions, requests for retrials, and for appeals and have specifically forbidden anyone from interviewing the subject.

It was Los Angeles' intention to interview [REDACTED] regarding his allegation that he had information about LEE HARVEY OSWALD prior to the assassination of former President KENNEDY, however, ROSS advises that psychiatric examinations given to [REDACTED] indicate he is emotionally unstable and given to fantasy and in view of [REDACTED] hostile attitude toward the FBI it is not felt that anything would be gained from such an interview.

In view of the above and the subject's current long sentence in the California State Prison System, no further investigation is being conducted in this matter by Los Angeles.
