What I would like to tell you about happened in Sep. 1963. The latter part of Sep. I was coming back from the Virgin Islands I stopped for a couple of days in Houston Texas, at, a small Hotel. Later if you send some one to let me tell them I Will, I do not Want any one here or any Place else, except you, People to hear this. About three years ago - I tried to tell two F-B-I men. They listened and seemed to be laughing at me - or at least I felt that way I never heard any more from them. The reasons I Waited so long - I Was afraid. Afraid of the gand - also my seperated husband at that time I didnt Want, him to hear about this & find me. Afraid it would get in the Papers or that I Would be called a crackpot - or liar ect. So I kept still. I kept thinking about this incident and as I am 64 years old before my memory all Vanishes about this I would like for you People to get the story I Want to tell you about the men several I heard Plotting the Death of Pres. Kennedy. There in Houston Texas. I knew who, they were talking about ect. of course I Never believed they could get the chance. I Wish now I had reported it, at the time. I didnt live in Texas & didnt Want to be delayed. No body would have listened to me then If I had told them these me planned and said With a cuss Oath He Would never get out of Texas alive That they Would, send him back to Washing in a Box - I can give you some descriptons of some of the men. Two especially and I am Postive one of the People Was Osborne and another young fellow I reconized Osborne when I saw his Picture I Met them in that hotel hall three or four times face to face. Also on the st. out side of the hotel. Also the other men. That met him there. I heard them two different times together talking. They didnt pay any attention to me I let on like I didnt nottice them. If you Wish I Will tell you all about the conversations. Now the men looked ect. as good as I can remember. I read the Warren Report ect. But I dont agree because I saw & heard these men. Several together.

these men several together

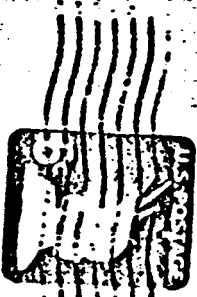
