On February 22nd I received your letter and the interest which prompted you to furnish your views is appreciated.

With respect to your comments, the FBI, at the direction of President Johnson, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and thorough investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. The results of that investigation were accurately reported to the Warren Commission which subsequently made the results of our inquiries available to the National Archives. The FBI has no authority to independently release any information contained in those reports.
