EMORY L. BROWN, JR. v. MITCHELL, ET AL.

Reference is made to your letter of March 10, 1971, relative to captioned matter, in which you request that a rough draft of a proposed affidavit containing the facts which support and explain the refusal to grant plaintiff access to information contained in our files be submitted to you.

Enclosed is a proposed affidavit for your consideration. You will note that we attempted to incorporate in the affidavit much of the information contained in the draft affidavit submitted to us with referenced letter. However, we are of the opinion that some of the matter contained in the Saloschin draft affidavit goes beyond that which an employee of this Bureau could properly aver. Certainly the points he raises are pertinent and perhaps could be utilized in the Department's arguments in support of the Government's position.
