Foresaw death of President Kennedy

Staying in New Ross this week is a Californian, Walter W. Amenhauser, from Long Beach, who had a vision in 1937 that the President would be assassinated in the latter part of 1963 in Dallas, Texas.

In 1961, he went to explain his vision to a lawyer, Mr. John W. Kerrigan, who exhorted him to get in touch with an F.B.I. agent. Mr. Kerrigan put him in touch with Mr. Clayton Taylor, an F.B.I. agent, on 14th December, 1961. Mr. Amenhauser revealed his vision to Mr. Taylor.

Mr. Amenhauser also had a vision that the United States would be attacked in a war holocaust in 1968. He now fears that the Middle-East situation will develop into a world war. That is one of the reasons he is in Europe. He had written to Adenaur and De Gaulle and decided to come to Europe to try and see them. "I only got within twenty miles of De Gaulle. I am here in Ireland now hoping to settle down, for I know that Ireland will be spared in this world war that is going to happen."

Warning Ignored

Mr. Amenhauser said that he had contacted Congressmen and Senators about his visions. He had made recordings and had written to President Johnson. He had also written to and had a reply from the late Robert Kennedy whom he warned not to run for the Presidency. He also tried to get people to persuade President Kennedy not to go to Dallas in 1963.

Mr. Amenhauser, who is a convert, has fears for his health because of his visions, and hopes to get some relief here in Ireland. He spent four months in Lourdes "in the hope of getting relief from this severe harassment that I am getting."
