between the first day of January, 1971, and the day of June in the year our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy one with force and arms in the Parish of Orleans aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of the Crimical District Court for the Parish of orleans, did wilfully and unlawfully violate R.S. 14:122, relative to Public Intimidation in that they used force and threats upon the District Attorney of New Orleans, Jim Garrison, in order to influence his conduct in relation to his position and duty, namely the communication of certain truths to the people of the United States, which hitherto have been withheld from them by the federal government of the United States and its employees,

contrary to the form of the Statute of the State of Louisiana in such case made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the same.
