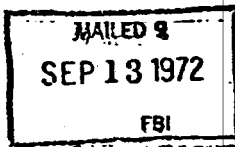

NOTE: John Nicholas, Petitioner, has filed a Writ of Certiorari in the U. S. Supreme Court which appealed the denial for access to evidentiary items preserved by the Government in connection with captioned assassination. It was his claim that the Archivist of the U. S. and the Department of the Navy had wrongfully refused to make available to him records to which he was entitled. U. S. Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit had affirmed ruling of the District Court of Kansas. Petition being returned to WFO per their request in referenced communication.
