On 9/24/73 SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING of the Dallas Office received a "CTIA Newsletter" addressed to him as "Robert P. Gemberling, FBI - Dallas Field Ofc., 200 Mercantile Cont'l Bldg., Dallas, Texas 75201". The "CTIA Newsletter" is a publication of the Committee To Investigate Assassinations, 1520 16th Street, N.W., Suite 101, Washington, D.C.; 20036, telephone 202-232-1152.

This newsletter indicated the Committee To Investigate Assassinations was holding a two-day conference on November 23 and 24, 1973, at Georgetown University to be presented jointly by the committee and the University. It indicated that it was expected to attract as speakers and panelists a large number of experts representing diverse views on the several cases, referring to the assassinations of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY, MARTIN LUTHER KING and the shooting of Governor GEORGE WALLACE.
