We have had substantial correspondence with Dr. Nichols concerning the assassination of President Kennedy and our dealing with him have been circumspect. Dr. Highols filed an unsuccessful suit against the United States and the Archivist in which he sought certain FBI Laboratory data dealing with the assassination. On August 2, 1973, he was furnished certain photographs which he had requested in connection with the assassination of President Kennedy.
