Dear Senator Case:

Your communication of December 4th enclosing correspondence from your constituent, Mr. David Blaess, has been received.

With respect to his inquiry, I can tell you that the FBI, at the direction of President Johnson, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and thorough investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. The results of this investigation were accurately reported to the Warren Commission and all available evidence and facts point to one conclusion--that Oswald acted alone in his crime.

We furnished the results of our inquiries to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy. The Commission published its findings and included FBI data in its report. Perhaps a copy of this document would be available to your constituent at his local library.

As you requested, your enclosure is returned herewith.
