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# WAKE UP AMERICA!

When JFK defeated Nixon in the 1960 election, the CIA began to plan up the arms of the anti-Castro Cuban exiles in Miami. Having worked closely with Vice-President Nixon before planning the Bay of Pigs invasion through Gen. Curtis E. LeMay and other CIA officials, the Cubans had been forced to postpone the action until after the election because of inclement weather. Now they were dealing with an unknown quantity -- JFK -- rather than Nixon, a man who served a career out of anti-Communism and who had later described as the Operations Officer for the Eisenhower-sponsored Bay of Pigs.

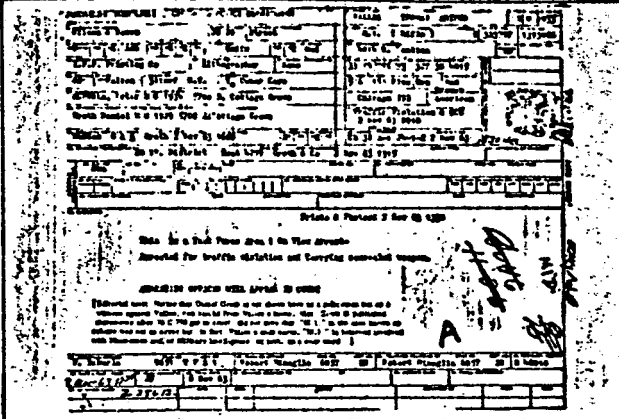
Shortly after the election, plans for the invasion were presented to JFK by Howard Hunt, who still served as a liaison between the Executive Branch and the CIA operative branch and the CIA operative assigned to planning and implementing the action. Their strategy was to have the US Air Force hit Cuba and then land a battalion of Cuban refugees who'd march through the rubble and murder the Castroites in the help of sympathetic countermeasures.

Altho Kennedy was down on direct US military intervention, preferring an Alliance For Progress approach in fighting Communism in Latin America, he was convinced by his military advisors that some action had to be forthcoming because of the commitment, so he allowed the Cubans to train for the invasion on US soil and supplied them with arms. Things looked good for the anti-Castroites until just before the invasion when Kennedy America's shores. The plan was to go 4,000 miles

Rather than cancelling the action away and do it, Kennedy made the greatest mistake of his short lifetime -- he pulled the air cover but allowed the invasion to go on without the Air Force's saturation bombing. Many of the Cubans must have sworn they ever got out of Cuba alive, they'd kill Kennedy.

When E. Howard Hunt tried to retrace JFK's actions to the Cuban refugees, he loved and respected, they spit on him. Once a symbol of America's anti-Castro commitment, Hunt had to bear the brunt of the Cuban's criticism. He too must have sworn to get JFK.

He'd also failed the acid test of the military-industrial complex by being soft on Communism. Kennedy was to be shot while he attended an Army-Navy football game at Chicago's Soldier's Field. Thomas Arthur Valle, a military intelligence agent who was a look-alike for a petty thief, was assigned to shoot him with a high-powered rifle. 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Another part of the Chicago plot uncovered by Stelmick involved the assassination having access to Secret Service credentials. A black SS agent named Albert Bolden wanted to testify about this part of the assassination but Valle's son, couldn't pry him by any other than the State's attorney Ed Hanrahan, another CIA operative in on the murder of Black Panther Fred Hampton's son.

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If it didn't work -- it was on to Dallas where Valle would be joined by three hitmen Frank Sergio, an ex-marine turned sniper, and two others who would be in charge of carrying out the assassination. Sergio, Castro announced there was no room for vice or hired killers in a Marxist society and he'd be the boss. He became a leader of ALFA-68, a SUPER-revolutionary faction of the Cuban movement and went as far as trying to assassinate and dropping anti-Castro leaflets, despite heavy radio surveillance.

Frank, an expert marksman, lurked behind the grassy knoll under the supervision of some other Dan E. Howard Hunt (who'd become obsessed with his hatred for Kennedy) and fired the fatal shots. Valle, who'd spent the night in a special part of the Book Depository Building, shot at Kennedy from there, catching him in a crossfire. The rifle he used had been stolen from Oswald's garage a few nights before.

In the confusion that followed the shooting, Hunt and Sergio fled to some nearby buscars, under the watchful eye of a Secret Service agent who had pulled Valle away from the grassy knoll, announcing that he had the arms covered. One of the team's support men, Jim Hicks, was spotted at the knoll with a radio transmitter and was a witness of Garrison's Clay Shaw Conspiracy Trial. He's now in the Federal Mental Hospital.

Valle was on out of the Book Depository and over to the buscars where the 3 billion rendezvous. In the aerial view of the Daily Plaza area, reprinted on this page, you can see how the killers met about halfway between the knoll and the Book Depository. Someone saw Valle leave the building -- in the direction of the Warren Report, told numbers and associations, so that a Mrs. Jean Hill stated that after the firing stopped she saw a white man, wearing a brown overcoat and hat, running away from the book building in the direction of the railroad tracks. The report goes on to say that her testimony wasn't corroborated by films and other witnesses and the Police were unable to come up with the identity of the man.

Since the FBI was in on the plot, the CIA-operators who planned it, decided the best way to get the witnesses out of the area would be to have them disguised as bums and have the Police pick them up and escort them them to a nearby Stambouli. They'd be held there until...

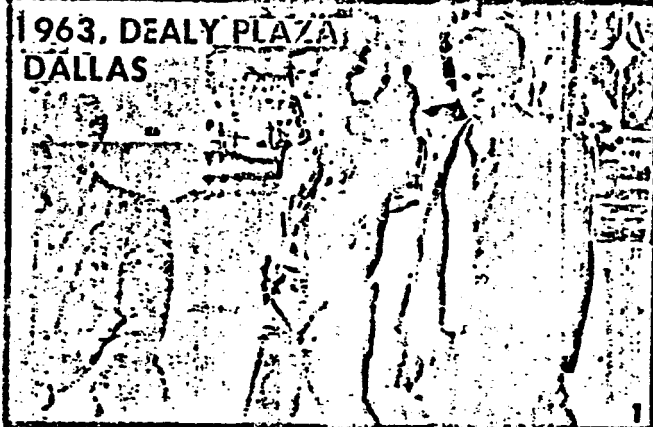

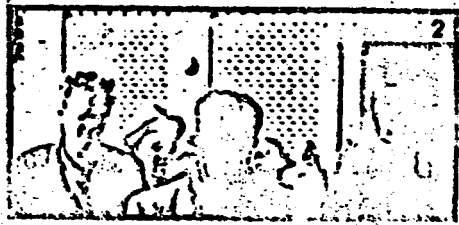

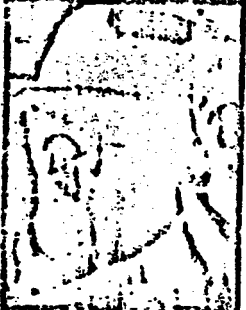
