This article also refers to a new book by GEORGE O'TOOLE, former head of the Central Intelligence Agency's problem analysis branch which O'TOOLE says will prove LEE HARVEY OSWALD did not kill anyone in Dallas on 11/22/63.

- (7) "The Dallas Morning News", Dallas, Texas, of 3/9/75, captioned "Hays, Hughes Are Satisfied With Warren Report on JFK". This article indicates BROOKS HAYS, a Special Assistant to the late President Kennedy and Federal Judge SARAH T. HUGHES, Dallas, are satisfied with the results reflected in the Warren Report.
- (8) "The Dallas Morning News", Dallas, Texas, of 3/11/75, captioned "Voice Test Cited - Did Oswald Tell Truth". This article refers to former CIA employee GEORGE O'TOOLE's new book "The Assassination Tapes".
- (9) "The Dallas Times Herald", Dallas, Texas, of 3/12/75, captioned "No Police Coverup in JFK Case, Curry Says". This article reflects public statements of former Chief of Police Jesse Curry, Dallas, Texas.
