these allegations is not deemed necessary.

NOTE: Gallagher voluntarily appeared at Seattle office on
8/6/75 and furnished info re allegedly observing a meeting
in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, during first week in November, 1963,
between Lee Harvey Oswald and Clay Shaw. He claims he over-
heard Shaw tell Oswald, "If we cannot elect to office the
man we want we will vote him out of office with a rifle."
Gallagher requested to be given a polygraph examination to
establish credibility to his story. Bureau files show that
Gallagher's information has been brought to the attention of
the Bureau several times over the years since the assassination.
It has been thoroughly investigated and the results were
furnished to the Warren Commission.
