WARREN COMMISSION DOCUMENT DECLASSIFIED IN MARCH 1975 OF WILLIAM T COLEMAN JR AND DAVID SLAWSON TO J. "THE FOREGOING IS PROBABLY ONLY A WILD SPECULATION, BUT THE FACTS WE ALL READY KNOW ARE CERTAINLY SUFFICIENT TO WARRANT ADDITIONAL INVESTIGATION"

THE ABOVE WAS WRITTEN IN THE SPRING OF 1964. I HAVE DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING THAT THIS IS NOT "WILD SPECULATION" BUT THE ACTUAL MOTIVE FOR THE ASSINATION. I WILL DELIVER THESE DOCUMENTS AT YOUR CONVENIENCE.
