During a recent discussion with Congressman Dale Milford, he advised me that he was appointed to the House select Committee on Intelligence Activities. I mentioned that legislation may become necessary as a result of the Committee's hearings and he offered to assist in forming any such legislation. I commented that any proposed legislation would have to go through the Department, and asked whether he would have any objection if I were to advise the Department of his offer of assistance. He said he had no objection whatsoever.

Therefore, should you desire to confer with a Member concerning legislative proposals related to the work of the House select Committee you may wish to accept Congressman Milford's offer.
