In the past few weeks I have been receiving a number of requests from my constituents asking that I introduce legislation that would re-open investigation into the assassination of the late President John F. Kennedy, in light of recent speculation about the possible involvement of a conspiracy, and alleged knowledge of Oswald's presence in Dallas as well as the possible threat therein.

Before taking such a step, I would like to get the official position of the Justice Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation on this new evidence and the general subject of re-activating the investigation. I would like to receive your statement as soon as possible.
