Following ANDREWS' revelation of this reported telephone call, former New Orleans District Attorney JIM GARRISON, while conducting his investigation into the assassination of President KENNEDY, unsuccessfully tried to prove that CLAY SHAW (deceased) was identical to BERTRAND.

New Orleans feels that should additional investigation be considered appropriate at this time as a result of statement, this investigation should commence with interviews at Lowry Air Force Base or Fitzsimmons Hospital.
