Dear Congressman Moore:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of November 17th on behalf of a constituent who has requested the results of a neutron activation analysis conducted by the FBI Laboratory in connection with the investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy.

The information which your constituent desires has been released in response to previous requests under the Freedom of Information Act. The analysis consists of 73 pages and will be sent to your constituent upon payment of duplication costs of 10 cents per page. It is suggested that your constituent send his request for the analysis directly to FBI Headquarters, attention Freedom of Information Act Section, Washington, D. C. 20535, enclosing a check or money order in the amount of \$7.30, payable to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
