Pear President Ford:


On November 4, 1075, Robert Fetz, representing an organization out of Boston looking into the resassingtions of President John F. Kennedy, Fenator Pobert F. Kennedy, Dr. Partin Lutier King, Jr., and the attempted assassination of Governor George Fallace, spoke to an audience of at least 1.500 people, made up of students and townspeople, on the possibilities of a conspiracy and cover-up of the killing of President Kennedy. His presentation of slides and oral expertise left most of the crowd in a state of spock and amazement.

It is in the opinion of the University of Misconsin-Platteville's Student Senate, from the evidence shorm, that the Useren Commission made a rushed judgement, that they were not supplied with truthful evidence given to them by the FBI, that the Commission did not carefully study key witnesses, that the strange number of deaths connected to the assassination seems to lead to some type of cover-up, and that the evidence now known to the American public warrants a new investigation into the killing.

Therefore, it is our wish as representatives of our students and as citizens of this country to want and to demand a better answer to that ugly scene in Dallas tuelve years ago. We are concerned, like millions of other follow Americans, as to whom is running this country—the people, or special interest groups. We evait your reely:
