Dear Mr. Levi;

After viewing a recent inquiry conducted by a national news agency, I find that there was a lot of material left out, for one reason or another, to help control the facts of the John Kennedy assassination.

Recently, there was a murder in Chicago. Sam Giancana was killed to keep him from talking to anyone about his part involving him with factions of the Castro power structure and any involvement of the C.I.A. with that group. I have a name: [redacted] Check this name with arrest records in Oak Park Illinois. SHE was an associate of Giancana and a gun connection for him and other members of organized crime in that area. That name will produce some results that have never been brought out but I might add, don't let the agency that investigates this information be connected with the C.I.A. OR the F.B.I.

I sincerely hope the information will help bring new light to the investigation into the killing of John Kennedy. I also hope that this information has reached hands that can be trusted and not suppressed, as has so much other material. I cannot trust the F.B.I. or the C.I.A. so that is why I have shown you. In this case, criminals are allowed to investigate themselves and the results are obvious.
