Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas

of December 15, 1975, for Tim Oliphant (phonetic). This call
was returned the morning of December 15, 1975, and the telephone
number was for the Select Committee on Intelligence, Washington,
D. C. The operator advised the calling party was out of the office
and had gone to FBI Headquarters.

Department, advised December 15, 1975, that on December 12, 1975, he received a telephone call from Tim Oliphant, Select Committee on Intelligence, Washington, D. C. Oliphant advised that the committee had received information that a former police officer, Daire I Edvard McMillan, had stopped a woman at Ardmore, Oklahoma, the night before President John Fitzgerald Kennedy was assassinated. This somen was hysterical and told McMillan that something bad was going to happen to the President in Dallas, Texas, the following day.

Millan also stated that he made his report on this incident to the Ardmore Police Department.

advised that a search of his records were negative on such a report.

also advised that he, was Chief of Detectives at the time the above alleged incident took place, and he does not recall any such incident. Further, other members of the Police lepartment, who were working at that time, do not recall any such incident.

Department June 17, 1963 to November 16, 1967, at which time he was forced to resign from the Department for He later worked as City Marshal, Cyril, Oklahoma, where he was charged with and dismissed. Disposition of charges is unknown. Lindsay lurnished the above information to Oliphant.

in the Oklahoma City Division in August, 1970, in which he was accused of hitting on the head with a blackjack when resisted arrest. Upon completion of the investigation, Assistant U. S. Attorney, Western District of Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, advised that the case had no prosecutive merit, and therefore the case was closed.

No record of the incident mentioned by McMillan could be located in Oklahoma City records. The agent assigned to Ardmore at that time was Senior Resident Agent, now deceased.
