On December 17, 1975, Littleton, New Hampshire, advised that on the evening of December 6, 1975, he was watching the ABC news program wherein commentator David Schoumaker stated that an investigation was being conducted in relation to the killing of former President John F. Kennedy. believed he had information regarding the assassination and advised as follows:

stated he first met the President in the states 1957 when Kennedy was serving as a Senator from the State of Massachusetts. Was living in Northampton, Massachusetts at the time and was having difficulty with his discharge papers from the military service. in solving this problem with his discharge papers.

In January of 1955, was working in a ski shop, repairing skis, at ML.
