[REDACTED] OMAHA, NEBRASKA, ADVISED DECEMBER

13, 1975, THAT HE RECALLS [REDACTED] IN THE
MOBILE DIVISION DURING NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER, 1963.

ARMROUSE ALSO RECALLED THAT HE WAS ONE OF THE AGENTS WHO
CONTACTED [REDACTED] DURING THAT PERIOD OF TIME. HOWEVER,
ARMROUSE DOES NOT REMEMBER THE SPECIFIC DATES HE CONTACTED

[REDACTED] NOR DOES HE REMEMBER IF THE CONTACTS WERE MADE AT
THE FBI OFFICE.

ARMROUSE ADVISED THAT HE NEVER CONTACTED [REDACTED] PRIOR
TO THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY FOR INFORMATION

CONCERNING LEE HARVEY OSWALD NOR DID HE EVER SHOW [REDACTED] A PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION. AMBROSE SAID HE HAD NEVER HEARD THE NAME LEE HARVEY OSWALD NOR DID HE KNOW WHO OSWALD WAS UNTIL AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OCCURRED.

AMBROSE SAID THAT AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OCCURRED HE POSSIBLY MAY HAVE CONTACTED [REDACTED] CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION SINCE HE RECALLS THAT ALL [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] WERE REQUESTED TO BE CONTACTED ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION. HOWEVER, IF HE DID, HE DOES NOT REMEMBER THE CONTENTS OF THE CONVERSATION.

AMBROSE SAID THAT HE WENT TO LANGUAGE SCHOOL IN MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA, IN JANUARY OF 1964 AND WAS TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED BY [REDACTED] A FEW WEEKS AFTER ARRIVING AT MONTEREY. AMBROSE TOLD [REDACTED] NOT TO CONTACT HIM SINCE HE WAS NO LONGER IN THE MOBILE OFFICE. AMBROSE SAID THAT THEY DID NOT DISCUSS ANY CASES BECAUSE AMBROSE WAS [REDACTED] OFF BEFORE MOORE COULD TELL HIM ANYTHING.

AMBROSE SAID THAT HE DID NOT TALK TO [REDACTED] ONE MONTH

AFTER THE ASSASSINATION ABOUT AN INTERVIEW WITH [REDACTED]
PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION OR THE SHOWING TO [REDACTED] OF A
PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION.

AMOROSE SAID THAT DURING THE TIME HE CONTACTED [REDACTED]
HE CONSIDERED [REDACTED] UNRELIABLE. THIS EVALUATION WAS BASED
BOTH ON HIS OWN PERSONAL OBSERVATIONS AND THROUGH INTERVIEWS
WITH OTHER INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING ONE [REDACTED], A
GAMBLING FIGURE IN THE MOBILE AREA AT THAT TIME.
