Let me make it clear that I am not endorsing his report or his findings, I am merely adhering to his request to forward his report on to your office. He feels my forwarding on his report to you might insure that his report is treated with more deference and respect than if he were merely to submit it himself.

I would hope that an appropriate subordinate of yours will read the document, analyze it and in view of the Warren Commission's findings, appropriately respond to him.
