Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of an LHM dated and captioned as above, with two copies for Miami, and one copy each for Alexandria and Washington Field for information.

SA [redacted] on 6/25/76, advised [redacted] that the party that always knows his whereabouts is his brother, [redacted]. He said he is currently staying for the next couple of weeks in Green Cove Springs, Florida, with his girlfriend [redacted].

[redacted] also stated that he was picked up by Cuban authorities in 2/70 when he was on a Spanish treasure hunting expedition, which made front page news at that time. He said he is a citizen of [redacted] and has [redacted]. He was served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 6/66 to 2/16/69. He said he was born on [redacted] at [redacted].

Information copy being furnished Alexandria and Washington Field in the event FBI Headquarters deems it appropriate for Alexandria to check CIA and Washington Field to check other Government agencies, such as Department of State, concerning the interrogation of the seven individuals upon their return from Cuba in 3/62.
