Enclosed for the Bureau are six (6) copies of an LHM concerning captioned matter which is self-explanatory.

[redacted] the complainant, is a 73-year old woman, and it was clearly apparent to the interviewing Agent that she has mental problems. [redacted] daughter, [redacted] is married to [redacted] an admitted alcoholic. The daughter has been confined for a mental problem. [redacted] lives with her daughter and son-in-law and three grandchildren, who are not offsprings of [redacted] and his wife.

[redacted] age 12, the eldest grandchild, was also interviewed and appeared to be quite stable. He advised his grandmother has a mental problem, [redacted] is an alcoholic and that [redacted] concocts and relates wild stories when intoxicated and that [redacted] believes the stories.

A check of NCIC failed to reflect any entry for [redacted] and no record could be found in the files of N. C. Department of Motor Vehicles indicating that he has a driver's license or automobile registered in his name. Charlotte indices also negative.
