ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963
DALLAS, TEXAS

On June 30, 1976, [redacted]
[redacted], Charlotte, North Carolina, telephonically
advised the Charlotte Office of the FBI that one [redacted]
[redacted] told her he was paid \$50,000 to assassinate
President KENNEDY. She said LYNDON JOINSON paid him
\$50,000 and JACQUELINE KENNEDY ONASSIS contributed money
to the overall execution of the plan.

[redacted] also advised [redacted] claimed he killed
eleven people before coming to North Carolina and he had
changed his name from FRANK ANGELINI (phonetic).
