After numerous unsuccessful attempts, Mrs. [redacted], aka [redacted], Apartment 203, Los Angeles, California was interviewed on 8/20/76, and provided the following information:

She advised that on 7/30-76, she was walking down 6th Street and as she passed "Sam's" Store, she overheard a Negro female telling three Negro males standing on the street, something to the effect that KENNEDY should have been killed. She could not identify or describe these Negroes. She then continued walking down 6th Street and entered Dun and Bradstreet, 6th and Park View, where she heard a man on the telephone say "You would bungle that mess in Texas." [redacted] then fled Dun and Bradstreet and returned to her residence where she wrote her letter to the FBI. [redacted] stated that the man on the phone at Dun and Bradstreet made no mention of President KENNEDY or the assassination, and she merely assumed that is what he was talking about. 62-109060-7554
