Dear Attorney General Levi:

In connection with my earlier personal investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy, my staff investigators had interviewed [REDACTED]. In light of the recent murder of alleged organized crime figure John Roselli, who admitted to involvement in Central Intelligence Agency plots against the life of Cuban Premier Fidel Castro, [REDACTED] contacted my staff to express concern for [REDACTED] own personal safety and sought some measure of protection. b7C

Accordingly, I am writing to request that you take whatever steps that are available to the Justice Department to insure [REDACTED] safety. In addition, I would appreciate knowing specifically what steps will be taken by the Justice Department in this connection. b7C

I suspended my investigation of the Kennedy assassination July 26 but feel I must promptly relay to you the expression of fear and request for some measure of protection which was today registered with my staff by [REDACTED]. b7C
