Enclosed for the Bureau are 6 copies of LHM setting forth information furnished by Mr. [redacted] to the Memphis Office of the FBI, and one xerox copy of sketch of apartment layout where OSWALD allegedly resided on Diceman Street in March, 1963.

Enclosed for Dallas Division are two copies of above LHM, one original of sketch; original of 8-page handwritten memorandum furnished by [redacted] and original Doyle brand Dallas map reportedly used by [redacted] to locate Diceman Street address in Dallas.

For information of the Bureau and Dallas, Mr. [redacted] personally appeared at the Memphis Office of the FBI 10/28/76 claiming he had information indicating that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had contact by mail with one JAKE RUBENSTEIN, aka JACK RUBY in March of 1963, seven months prior to the assassination. handwritten account of the events as he recalled them as well as a Dallas map which he used at the time in 1963 to locate the OSWALD residence and a map of the apartment complex where he learned OSWALD lived on Diceman Street. [REDACTED] noted there are two Diceman Streets on the Dallas map and he was unable to recall which of the two was the Diceman Street where he observed the name OSWALD on an apartment mail box.
