REQUEST TO MAINTAIN PERTINENT
KENNEDY - KING FILES IN ROOM 8988, JEH,
CONGRESSIONAL INQUIRY UNIT

PURPOSE: To request continuing authority to maintain those files relating to the assassinations of Martin Luther King, Jr., and President John F. Kennedy to respond to requests from the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA).

CURRENT BUREAU POLICY: Manual for Bureau Supervisors, Page 16, Item 26, dated 12/23/76, sets out, in part, that the continued necessity and authority for maintenance of files in space other than that controlled by Records Management Division must be reviewed semiannually and approved by the Deputy Associate Director (Administration).

RECOMMENDATION: That continuing authority be granted to maintain pertinent Kennedy - King files in Room 8988, JEH.
