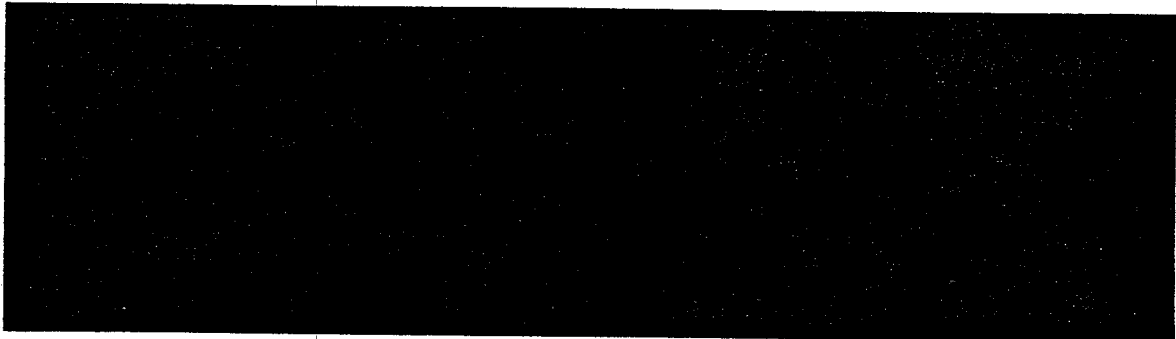

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] at Dallas, Texas, on July 21, 1977:

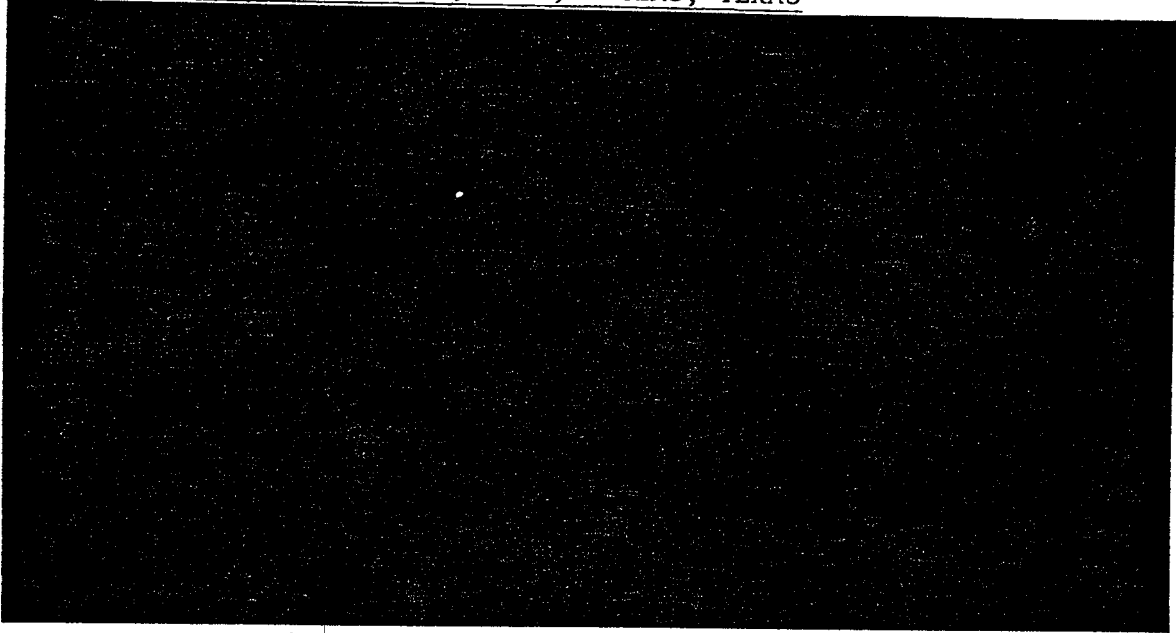
SA [REDACTED] walked the following routes in downtown Dallas, Texas:

The above-described walking route survey sets forth the approximate walking time between the U. S. Post Office Building, in which the [REDACTED] was located on November 22, 1963, and the Texas School Book Depository Building, in accordance with the route described by [REDACTED] during his interview with SAs of the FBI on February 7, 1977. This route appears to also be the most direct route between these locations as determined by SA [REDACTED] FBI, Dallas.
